Recipient	Amount of Funds	Detailed Explanation
<b>City of Cleveland</b> Countywide Interoperability Communications System <i>[Joint Request With Rep. Stephanie Tubbs Jones]</i>	\$650,000	The City will begin development of a countywide interoperability communications system that will eventually eliminate 47 different radio systems and provide for vastly improved emergency response communications.
<b>City of Garfield Heights</b> Transportation Blvd / Rockside Road Improvements	\$1,000,000	The City will reconstruct Transportation Blvd to improve safety, eliminate a bottleneck, and improve transportation flow in the area.
<b>Cleveland Botanical Garden</b> Green Corps Urban Youth Program	\$400,000	These funds will expand the Green Corps Urban Youth Program, an entrepreneurial work/study program that serves disadvantages urban teenagers by teaching horticultural and business skills.
<b>Cuyahoga County</b> Universal Pre-Kindergarten	\$300,000	The County has developed a first-rate Universal Pre-Kindergarten to serve our children. Research indicates that children exposed to solid educational programming in their formative years boost their opportunities in life.

<b>Federal Technology Group</b> Advanced materials manufacturing company with facilities in Lakewood, Ohio	\$500,000	The funds will help this high-tech company develop a manufacturing process to produce metallic glass in bulk. Metallic glass is a revolutionary material that could create a new industry in Northeast, Ohio.
<b>Senior Transportation          Connection</b> <i>[Joint Request With Rep.          Stephanie Tubbs Jones]</i>	\$300,000	These funds are a down payment on the replacement of 28 vehicles currently in service for transporting our senior citizens throughout the county.
<b>Vocational Guidance          Service</b> Non-profit job and service agency for those with disabilities	\$100,000	These funds will purchase additional sewing equipment for disabled workers to improve opportunities for enable future Defense Department contracts.
