# CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Calling upon the President to appeal to all sides in the current crisis in the Middle East for an immediate cessation of violence and to commit United States diplomats to multi-party negotiations with no preconditions.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*

2   *concurring), That Congress—*

3            (1) calls upon the President to—

1           (A) appeal to all sides in the current crisis  
2           in the Middle East for an immediate cessation  
3           of violence;

4           (B) commit United States diplomats to  
5           multi-party negotiations with no preconditions;  
6           and

7           (C) send a high-level diplomatic mission to  
8           the region to facilitate such multi-party negotia-  
9           tions;

10          (2) urges such multi-party negotiations to begin  
11          as soon as possible, including delegations from the  
12          governments of Israel, the Palestinian Authority,  
13          Lebanon, Iran, Syria, Jordan, and Egypt; and

14          (3) supports an international peacekeeping mis-  
15          sion to southern Lebanon to prevent cross-border  
16          skirmishes during such multi-party negotiations.
